IIOIAAR Award Regulation, Var 1.1 integration of 05/09/2017

AMSAT-NA, with the recent activation of satellite AO-85 (formally Fox-1A) in SSTV-FM mode on downlink frequency of 145,980 on Wednesdays of each week, provided an additional possibility of making connections with IIOIAAR that did not was envisaged at the time of drafting the Award IIOIAAR regulation.

For this reason, Amsat-I's IIOIAAR Award Manager considered it appropriate to integrate the regulation to allow so many radio amateurs who are unable to make qso 2-wais via satellite to participate in the Award. We recall that the Field Application 1 that requires 3 qso with satellite IIOIAAR or 5 listening reports for SWL is in fact a compulsory condition for accessing the diploma.

With the AO-85 SSTV-FM transmissions, we adds to the previous rules the additional possibility of overcoming the mandatory condition even with the reception of at least 3 SSTV transmissions performed by IIOIAAR / X . Scoring follows the same rules previously set, more qso and more points. However, the criterion remains that the Diploma requires at least another Field Application (2,3 or 4) to be activated besides the first one that is mandatory.

Hoping to have offered more opportunities to more enthusiasts, all interested OM are Invited to partecipate.
